When you're out in the countryside remember to follow the countryside code

Be safe, plan ahead and follow any signs

Leave gates and property as you find them

Protect plants and animals – take your litter home

Keep dogs under close control

Consider other people who live in, work on, and enjoy the countryside.

The countryside and public rights of way network are constantly changing – woodland may be planted, grass fields ploughed up or footpaths diverted. Weather and conditions underfoot will vary throughout the year. Before setting out be sure that you have suitable clothing and footwear appropriate for the day.
