

Intervention Rates – Overview Table

The following table provides an overview of the maximum intervention rates which will be applied for all applicant types and project categories. This is the maximum available and will be capped. Please note these are the maximum intervention rates for **all public sector intervention** (including European and Lottery funding) in the project, not just for the contribution requested from Single Programme. For full details of the intervention rates and eligibility criteria, please refer to the relevant sections below.
