# Play for Disabled Children Team

## **Breaks in Partnership project**

Breaks in Partnership offers disabled children and young people aged 5-16 years time limited play in the school holidays except for Christmas. This will be in an appropriate setting for the child or young person and close to the family home where possible.

### **Who can access the project?**

- Disabled children & young people aged 5-16 years
- Children & young people not in receipt of Inclusion Funding

### **How to access Breaks in Partnership**

Parents, carers, social workers, paediatricians and other professionals can refer a child/young person to the Breaks in Partnership project by contacting the Play for Disabled Team. Members of the team will then contact parent/carers and offer the child/young person a place in an appropriate setting. Parents and carers will then need to visit the setting.

### **How much will it cost?**

There is an annual cost of £44 per family. Some families may be exempt if they are in receipt of benefits.

## **Holiday Clubs Project**

The holiday club offers disabled children and young people aged 5-14 years play opportunities in specialist community play settings during the school holidays except for Christmas. Places will be reviewed after 12 months and where possible children / young people will be transferred to settings supporting the Breaks in Partnership Project

### **Who can access the Holiday Clubs Project?**

- Disabled children & young people aged 5-14 years
- Children & young people not in receipt of Inclusion Funding
