The Purpose of the Event

This event brings together the key themes of recognising vulnerability in young people (aged 9 to 18) and inter-agency working. The aim is to increase practitioner confidence in working with young people and their families and how to contribute to the assessment of need and risk, plan and provide intervention and review progress.

Learning Outcomes

By the end of this event participants will be able to;

- Recognise signs of vulnerability in older children and young people
- Understand individual and organisational perspectives regarding practitioner roles and responsibilities to act on concerns
- Identify and address potential barriers to improving outcomes for vulnerable young people
- Explore issues around the assessment of need and risk and the concept of defensible decision making
- Critically reflect on the complexities of multi-agency working and the importance of understanding the young person's daily experience.

Who is it for? - The event is open to practitioners from children and adult services that work with young people and/or adults and families within the multi-agency arena and are likely to contribute to the assessment and provision of multi-agency intervention. Applicants should have completed a Working Together to Safeguard Children course prior to attending this course.
