

## Nottinghamshire Community Safety Strategic Plan (2008-11)

This plan outlines how the Safer Nottinghamshire Board (SNB) will work together to improve community safety across the county over the next three years.

This leaflet outlines the key objectives of the plan. *The overall aim is to build safer communities, ensuring that residents are confident that the community safety issues which matter most to them are being tackled effectively.*

The Board understands that each community safety problem needs its own specific solution and that local people are the key element in building stronger and safer neighbourhoods.

## Safer Nottinghamshire Board

The Safer Nottinghamshire Board (SNB) is a partnership that has been set up to improve the lives of people who live in, work in and visit Nottinghamshire, by working together to reduce crime, anti-social behaviour, substance misuse and improve community cohesion.

It is made up of a number of different agencies including Nottinghamshire Police, Nottinghamshire Fire and Rescue Service, County, District and Borough Councils, NHS, Probation and the voluntary sector.

The Board acts as an over-arching body within which partners can work together to build safer communities. It has a focus on dealing with such issues as burglary, car crime, drug use and prevention, domestic violence and adult re-offending.

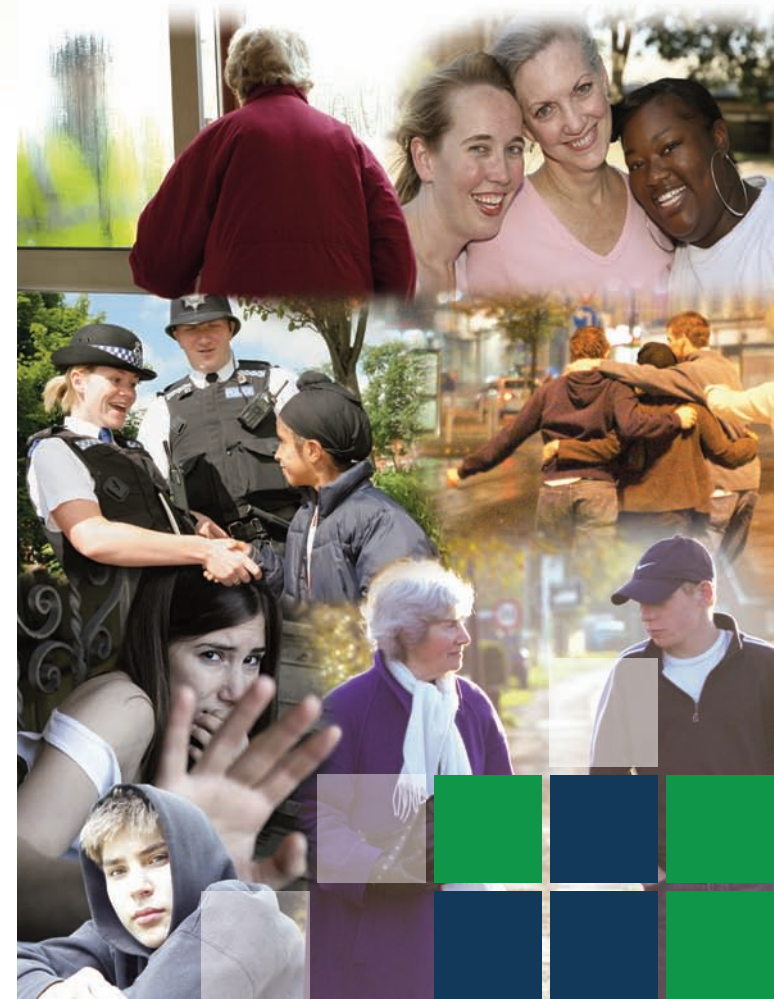

# Key objectives

## Objective 1: Early intervention

- Building stronger and more united communities across the county
- Prevent and reduce offending by children and young people
- Prevent and reduce the risk of substance misuse by children and young people

## Objective 2: Prevention of crime

- Reduce violent crime
- Reduce burglary, car crime and robbery
- Prevent and reduce re-offending by adults
- Prevent and reduce drug and alcohol misuse by adults

## Objective 3: Increase the confidence and satisfaction of local communities

- Respond effectively to community safety issues raised by local people
- Prevent and reduce levels of anti-social behaviour
- Support victims, including families and vulnerable communities
- Work with local crime and disorder partnerships to address those issues that concern local people the most
