The Purpose of the Events

These events bring together the key themes of inter-agency working and complex case work. The aim is to increase practitioner confidence in working with families to contribute to assessments of needs and risks, provide intervention and review progress. This involves creating conditions where change can take place and engaging families in this process.

Learning Outcomes

By the end of the events participants will have been able to;

- Explore and understand the complexities of multi-agency practice
- Explore the concepts of motivation and change
- Consider the challenge of engaging parents and facing resistance
- Reflect on how to maintain focus on the child
- Recognise and consider the worker's own needs
- Understand risk analysis and risk management when complex adult problems are present, such as; parental mental health, parental substance use, domestic abuse and learning disability.

Who is it for? - These events are open to practitioners from children and adult services that work with children, young people and/or adults and families within the multi-agency arena and are likely to contribute to Core Group working.
